Emphasizing instruction and action-based learning, this track is for those who want to launch a teaching career at a business school or bolster their credentials as a current business instructor.

To earn the Teaching Track designation a student must meet four additional requirements:

- 1. Comple DBA501
- 2. Comple DBA502
- 3. Comple a research paper related to instructional design and delivery techniques or research related to curriculum and instruction, such as an action-learning project while teaching a lab, workshop, or course module under advisor guidance.
- 4. Complete a thesis related to instructional design and delivery or research related to curriculum development
